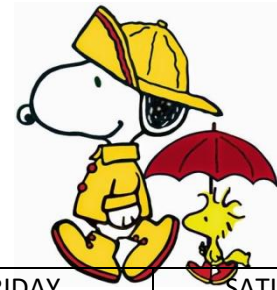

Week 1 – Objective: What do we know about recycling?

Book: The Paperbag Princess

Week 2 – Objective: What do people throw away?

Book: I Stink

Week 3 – Objective: Where does trash go?

Book: Garry and Harry

Week 4 – Objective: How does trash affect our community?

Book: Sam Helps Recycle

Summary: Trash and garbage are all around us, let's use it as a learning opportunity. Children are fascinated by what is thrown in garbage cans. What is laying in the street, and where the garbage goes once it leaves our homes. Let's use this natural curiosity to explore reducing, reusing and recycling. In this study our children will observe and gather information, explore our community, and learn problem-solving skills. This month we will learn not only about recycling but about how our community is affected by garbage
